
Why Yale developed a comprehensive program?

- > To ensure:
 - Shippers Trained & Certified to ship Research/Clinical Materials
 - > Proper Shipping Documentation
 - Easy access for FAA/DOT inspections
 - Proper Packaging and Labels for shipments
- Provide timely Export Control reviews
- > Focus EHS & Research/Clinical staff resources
- > Increase in Regulatory Scrutiny by FAA, DOT and DOC



Challenges

- ➤ Large Decentralized Campus
 - Shipping/Receiving occurring from many locations
- ➤ Most Grants require Sharing of Research Materials
- > Resistance to changing the status quo
 - Hazardous Material vs. Research Material
- > Time commitment
 - EHS Staff
 - Researchers/Clinical Staff
 - Time from Approval to Ship
- > Training
 - EHS Staff, Researchers, Clinical and Ancillary Staff


Beware !!!

Many companies provide shipping documents, labels and packaging for materials (e.g. – chemicals, radioactive sources, etc.) to be returned to the vendor for various reasons.


Inform staff to understand and recognize that only trained and certified shippers can process these shipments.






eShipGlobal - Workflow




The most prevalent type of research/clinical material being shipped from my institution is:




Research/Clinical Material Shipments by Type




How many Research/Clinical Shipments are known to be shipped from my institution annually?

2007 to Present





Champion Change

- ➤ Engage Upper Administration
- > Engage Committees
 - Research Compliance Committee
 - University Safety Committee
 - RSC, IBC and CLSC
- > Solicit Support from Researchers and Clinical Groups
 - Focus Groups
 - Meet directly with high volume shippers
- > Utilize all Communication Vehicles available
 - Newsletters, Targeted emails, website, etc.

Justification for Change

- > DOT/FAA
 - Fines \$1K-10,000K per violation
- > Dept. of Commerce Export Controls
 - Willful Violations- \$1M and 20 yrs imprisonment
- Negative Public Relations
- > Reporting of Violations
 - Granting Agencies
 - States

Basic Assumption

- > EHS responsible for Chemical & Radioactive Shipments
- Researchers/Clinical Staff will Continue to Ship Biological Materials
- > Export Controls Compliance Review by EHS required:
 - > Chemical,
 - > Radioactive,
 - > Category A and
 - > International Research Material
- > All Departments will use eShipGlobal/eShipLab
 - Eliminate individual department FedEx Accounts

Benefits of eShipLab

- Guaranteed Training for all shippers
- Improved Compliance
 - > Paperwork compliant with DOT/IATA regulations
 - Shipper's Declaration, Air waybills, Commercial Invoices, Labels
 - > Specific Packaging Instructions agreed upon by Shipper
 - > Required Shipping Documentation being maintained electronically
 - Easy access during regulatory audits
- > EHS time being properly utilized
 - > Radioactive and Chemical shipments are shipped by EHS Shipping Team Member
 - > Category A shipments reviewed and approved by EHS prior to shipping
 - Export Control reviews
- Reduced EHS and Researcher Staff time commitment
 - > Reviewing all shipments
 - > Export Controls reviews
- Reduced shipping cost for shipments

Future Goals and Enhancements

> EHS Goals

- Implement more robust Chemical and Radioactive Material Workflows (In Test)
- Integrate eShipLab with IATA Tables (In Test)
- Implement Import and Export Workflows (e.g.- USDA, CDC, etc.)
- Develop Business Processes for Animal Shipments

EHS/User Enhancements to eShipGlobal

- Automate Information forwarded to Chemtrec
- Implement Material Transfer Agreements
- Shipment Editing Capabilities
- Improve inbound shipment process
- Add Local Courier Services
- Improve reporting capabilities
